




# Reading Introduction

## **Red words**

Red words are tricky words that can't be sounded out but appear regularly in children's reading and writing.

Here are some of the first red words your child will read.

You could make a set of red words so your child can practise reading them - Remember to tell them they are red words so we can't sound them out we just have to look and say the word.

#### **Ask Questions**

Ask questions about the story as you read it e.g. What is the story about? Why do you think they made that choice? Was it a good choice? Why did that happen? What do you think will happen next? What was your favourite part of the story? Why?

#### Make it Fun

Enjoy-reading together. Give characters funny voices and engage with the pictures. Make a game out of finding words that rhyme or start with the same sound.

## Be Seen

Play 'I Spy' games. Can you find words beginning with ..? Can you find a picture of a..? How many... can you see?

#### Get Out

Go to your public library regularly. Find the books you loved as a kid to read together.

#### Create

Use reading to inspire drawings or new stories.

#### Go Online

Look online & in app stores for appropriate word & spelling games.

### Make Space



The worms need your help! All of their different body parts are numbered, but some of the numbers have gone missing!!! Can you help them figure out what the missing numbers are.








## Missing Number Worms!
