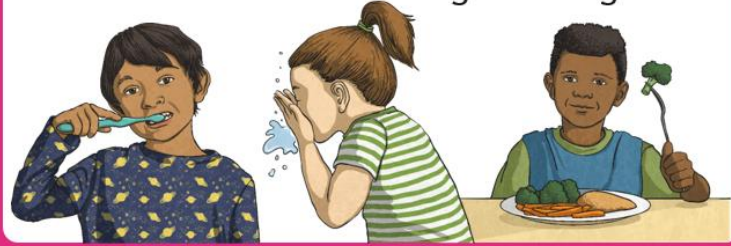


Staying safe

Today you are going to innovate the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

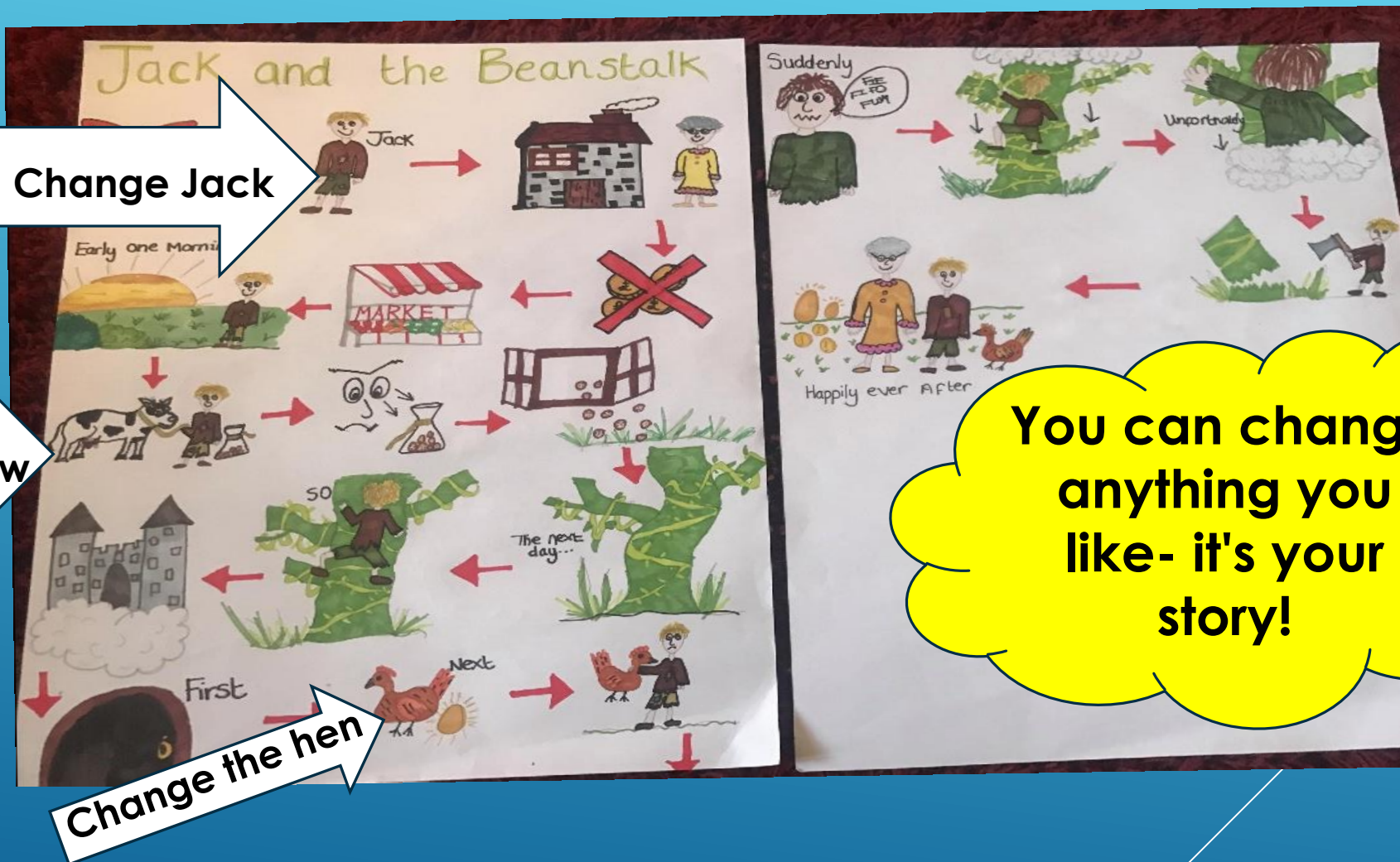
You could change the hen into one of the egg-laying animals in yesterday's list - an alligator that laid golden eggs!
