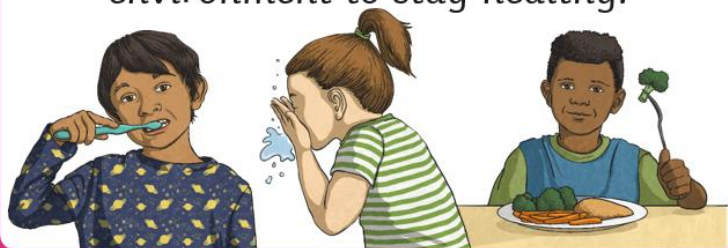


Staying safe

You have the right to the best possible health. You should have good quality health care, clean water, nutritious food and a clean environment to stay healthy.

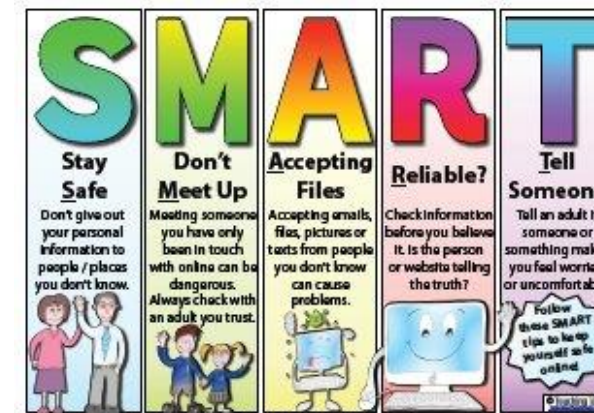


Article 19:

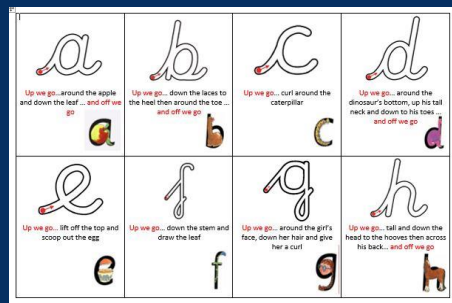

Maths Introduction

We are learning about *capacity*.

This time we are going to compare containers to find out which will hold the *most* water and which will hold the *least*.

Look at my 5 containers can you predict which will hold the most water?

You could use an egg cup or yoghurt pot!



I decided to use the ladle and counted how many ladle fulls I put in each container.

1. Choose your 5 containers.

2. What are you going to measure with?

3. Predict which you think will hold the most..

4. Predict how many you think you will need to fill the container?

5. Now measure!

You could fill in a table like mine.

Capacity

I am going to measure using a ladle.
I think the jug will hold the most water.

Big glass	6	5	X
Mug	7	7	✓
jug	14	13	X
Plastic cup	5	4	X
small glass	4	4	✓

I was correct the jug will hold the most water.

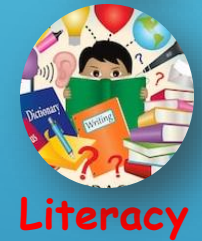

Discover what will blow over and what won't even move!

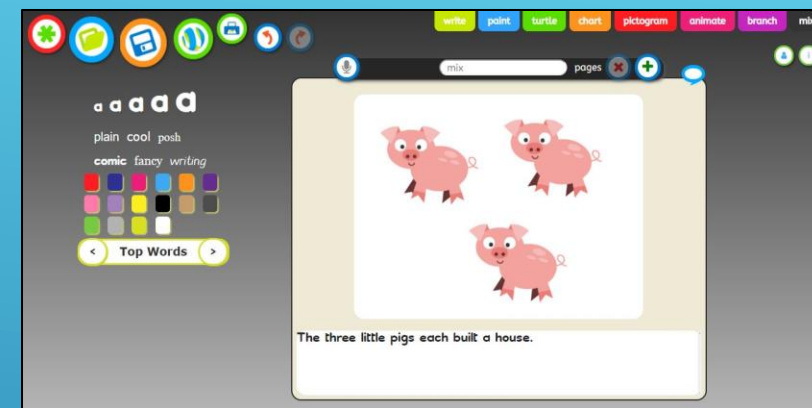
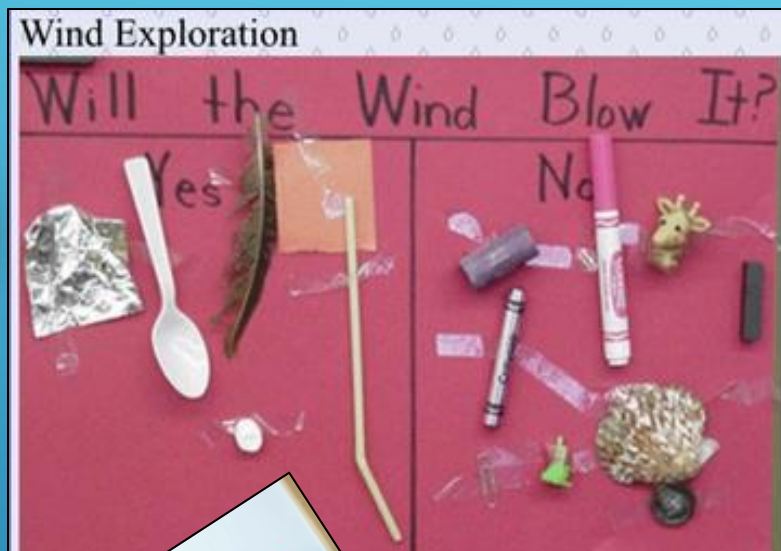
