




Staying safe

You have the right to the best possible health. You should have good quality health care, clean water, nutritious food and a clean environment to stay healthy.




Article 19:

Easy No Cook Playdough

Ingredients:

- · 2 c. flour
- 1 c. salt
- 3 tablespoons cream of tartar (powder)
- 2 tablespoons oil
- · 2 c. boiling water
- 1 tsp. Peppermint extract (optional)
- · Food coloring (optional)



No cooking required! Put all ingredients in a bowl and stir! Knead until smooth. Easy right?!? (Note: You cannot mess this one up!)

Topic Task grid

Squirmy Jelly Worms

Pack straws into a cup and secure with a rubber band.

Pour in jelly carefully.

Once jelly is set rinse with some warm water to release the "worms" from their straws!

Worm charming

Find a patch of grass and see if you can charm some worms to the surface!

Use wool or cooked spaghetti in paint for worm art!

Use playdough to make your own Super worm. Can you find out how long it is? You could measure using a ruler, measuring tape or Lego bricks. Can you make another worm which is longer?

Gummy worms, Baking Soda, Vinegar, Cutting Board, Sharp Knife, 2 Clear Cups

Cut the gummy worms in quarters.

Next, measure out 3 tablespoons of baking soda and stir them into a glass filled with 1 cup of warm water. Mix the cut worms into the baking soda and water concoction.

Now comes the hard part wait a whole 15

Now comes the hard part, wait a whole 15 minutes for the worms to soak in the baking soda mixture.

While you wait fill the second clear glass with vinegar.

After 15 minutes take the worms out of the glass then place just a couple of worms in the vinegar and they should form bubbles. After a few seconds the worms should start rising from the bottom, writhing their way to the surface.
