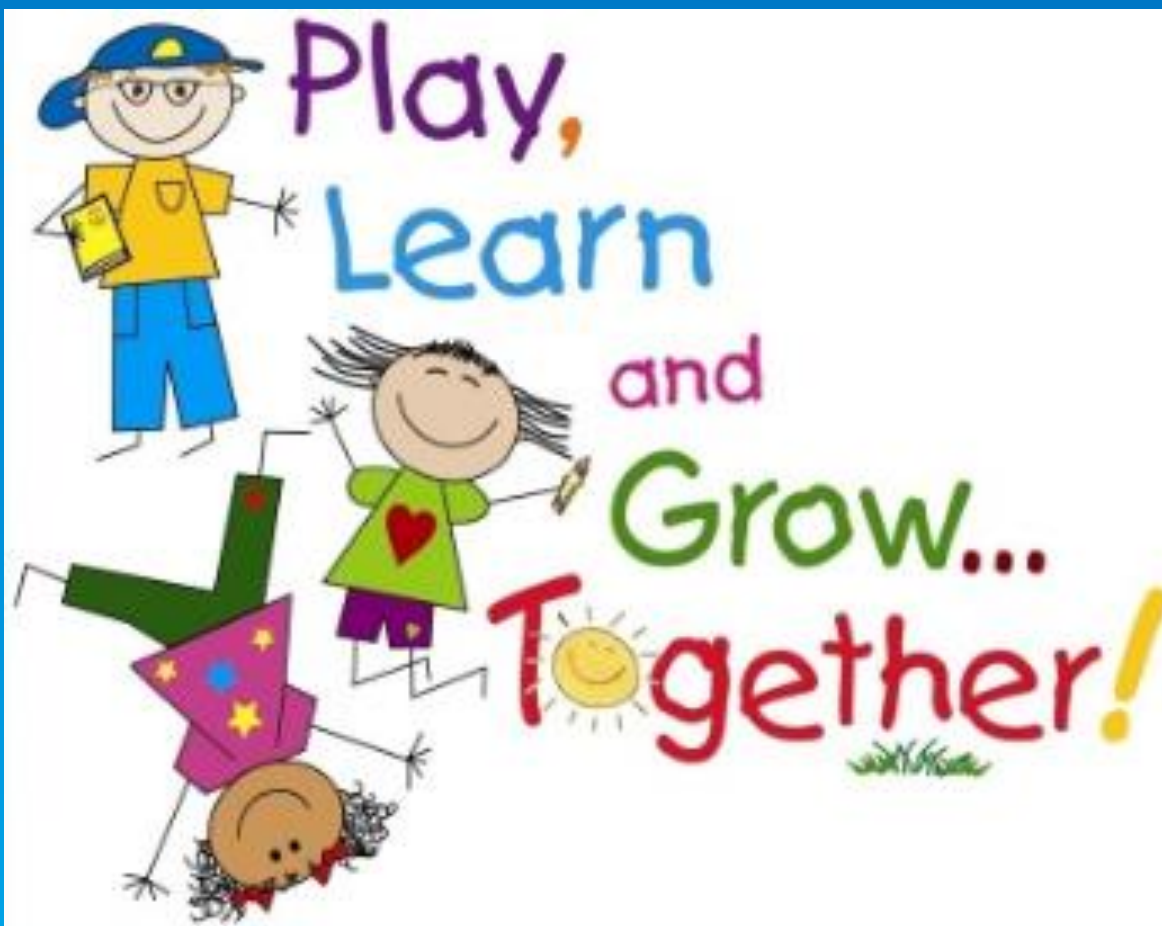

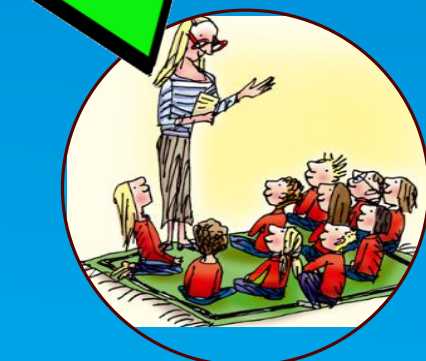

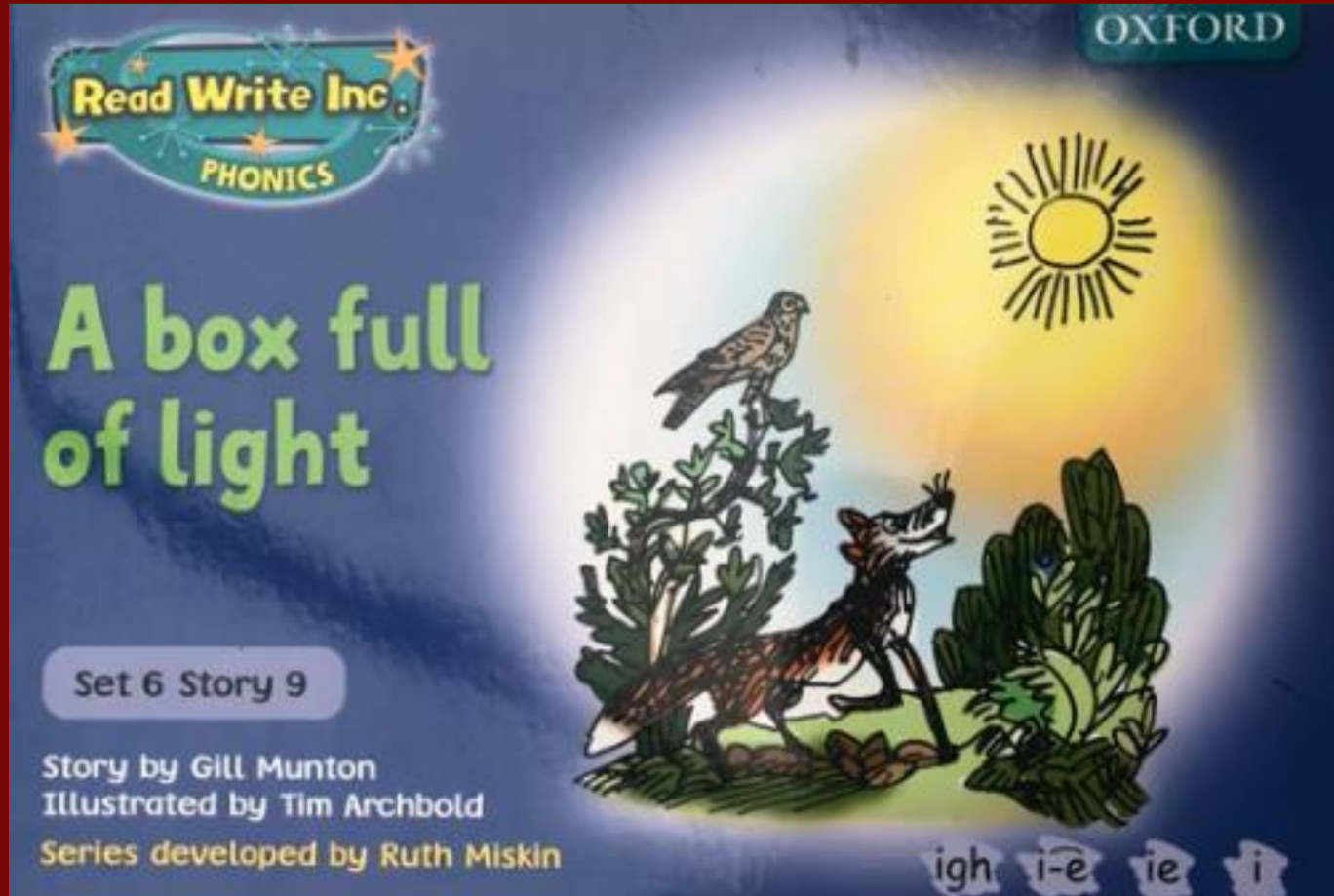

The teacher reads the story the first time using fluency and expression. It's an opportunity for the child to take in the pictures and enjoy listening to the whole story uninterrupted.



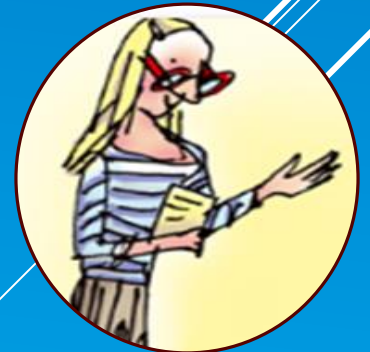
A box full of light

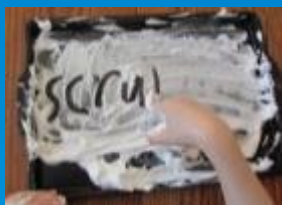
